INTRODUCTION

Under the leadership of His Excellence, the President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, Bola Ahmed Tinubu, GCFR, and the entire people of the Federal Republic of Nigeria wishes to extend a warm welcome to you to the 2024 African Caucus Meeting, scheduled to take place in Abuja, Nigeria, from August 1-3, 2024.

This meeting is hosted by the Honourable Minister of Finance and Coordinating Minister of the Economy, Wale Edun, OFR who is the Governor of the International Monetary Fund (IMF) and the World Bank Group (WBG) for the Federal Republic of Nigeria and Chair of the 2024 African Caucus.

GENERAL INFORMATION ON NIGERIA

- Nigeria is a multi-ethnic and culturally diverse federation of 36 autonomous states and the Federal Capital
 Territory, endowed with vast natural resources such as petroleum, limestone, tin, columbine, coal, led,
 marble, graphite, etc.
- Nigeria's population is estimated to be 229 million with Abuja as its capital. English is the official language
 of Nigeria while the most widely spoken local languages are Hausa, Yoruba, and Igbo.
- Nigeria has an estimated 250 ethnic groups, each inhabiting a territory that it considers to be its own by
 right of first occupancy and inheritance. There are beautiful tourist sites across the regions. For Abuja,
 we have the Zuma Rock, Jabi Lake, etc.
- Abuja, the Federal Capital Territory of Nigeria is located in the North Central part of the country, and is bounded by Kaduna State on the north, on south-east with Nasarawa State, on the south-west by Kogi State and on the west by Niger state.

ABUJA WEATHER

- Using the Köppen climate classification, Abuja features a tropical wet and dry climate. The FCT
 experiences three weather conditions annually; a warm and humid rainy season, a blistering dry season,
 a brief interlude of harmattan occasioned by the northeast trade winds, that are often associated with
 dust haze, intensified coldness and dryness.
- The rainy season begins from April and ends in October, with daytime temperatures range from 28 °C (82.4 °F) to 30 °C (86.0 °F) and nighttime lows hover around 22 °C (71.6 °F) to 23 °C (73.4 °F). In the dry season, daytime temperatures can soar as high as 40 °C (104.0 °F) and nighttime temperatures can dip to 12 °C (53.6 °F).
- Rainfall in the FCT reflects the territory's location on the windward side of the Jos Plateau.

REGISTRATION

- Delegates are required to present their passport and any other identification document at the accreditation centre to collect their meeting badges.
- Please note that the deadline for registration was extended from July 15th to July 22nd, 2024.

ENTRY FORMALITIES - VISA AND IMMIGRATION REQUIREMENTS

- All participants must hold a valid passport or legal travel documents with a minimum validity of SIX (6)
 months beyond the intended visiting period.
- Delegates are encouraged to submit their visa applications in their home country, if a Nigerian Embassy is present.
- Delegates that require visa on arrival should apply early.
- To obtain the visa on arrival, participants should use the following link: https://voa.immigration.gov.ng/
 and are required to produce and present both invitation letter and visa letter to the immigration authorities.
 Participants will bear the cost of Visa Issuance.

VENUE OF THE 2024 AFRICAN CAUCUS

- The meeting will be held at the Congress Hall of Transcorp Hilton, Abuja, Nigeria, N0:1 Aguiyi Ironsi St,
 Maitama, Abuja, Federal Capital Territory.
- The Hotel is set on picturesque landscaped gardens and sits at the heart of Nigeria's FCT and Abuja's commercial district. It is less than three kilometers from Abuja National Mosque and Millennium Park, and within 20 minutes of the city center. With an on-site casino, handicraft market, airline kiosks, 24-hour fitness center, and outdoor pool, you are sure to have a memorable conference and stay in Abuja.
- The Cocktail which is on the first day of the meeting will be held at the same Congress Hall, Transcorp Hilton.
- The Secretariat will be located at the Transcorp Hilton Hotel to assist you if needed.

AIRPORT PROTOCOL AND LOGISTICS

- A protocol team will be on ground to receive delegates upon arrival.
- A dedicated meeting protocol desk labeled with the African Caucus 2024 banner, will be available at both the Murtala International Airport, Lagos and the Nnamdi Azikiwe International and Domestic Airports in Abuja.
- There will be free transportation from the Murtala International Airport in Lagos to the domestic airports for delegates arriving via Lagos.
- There will be free transportation to the official hotels for all participants upon arrival at the Abuja airports.
 In this regard, participants are required to provide their travel itinerary and full flight details by providing the information requested on the website before July 15, 2024.

TRANSPORTATION

- PICK UP AND DROP OFF service will be provided between designated hotels to the meeting venue.
 Please, look out for shuttles with African Caucus Logo.
- Only Heads of Delegation will be provided with dedicated cars.
- Ground transport from the meeting venue to the hotel and vice versa will be provided for in-meeting movements. Cars will leave an hour and half before the meeting starts. and pick participants up after the meetings.

HEALTHCARE


A medical team will be available onsite throughout the meetings. An Ambulance Service and Clinic will

CURRENCY

- The local currency is the Naira which comes in denominations of three coins (50k, ₩1, and ₩2), eight banknote denominations (₩5, ₩10, ₩20, ₩50, №100, ₩200, ₩500, and ₩1000).
- Credit/debit cards (Visa, MasterCard etc.) are accepted by most establishments. Foreign currencies can
 be exchanged at the airport, the meeting venue and at registered Bureau de Changes. Please contact

TIME ZONE AND ELECTRICITY

- Local Time: Nigeria observes West Africa Time (WAT), which is one hour ahead of Coordinated Universal Time (UTC+01:00), year-round as standard time.
- Electricity in Nigeria is generated through thermal and hydropower sources. The main source of electricity
 generation comes from fossil fuels especially gas which accounts for 86% of the capacity in Nigeria with
 the remainder generated from hydropower sources.
- In Nigeria, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type D and type G are used with the primary power outlets being type G. The standard voltage is 230 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. Three (3) headed pin attachment plugs are in use.
